

Spree Prohibited Items or Services

The list below is not exhaustive, and Spree reserves the right to remove any ad that we believe is inappropriate, harmful or otherwise not in the spirit of the Spree buying and selling community. The list includes sellers seeking to sell or offer the below prohibited items or services and buyers seeking to buy or request the below prohibited items or services.

1. Adult and Mature Content

- a. Pornography and adult material including, but not limited to, pornographic books, magazines, movies and pictures.
- b. Adult toys and enhancement products.
- c. Adult industry services and jobs including, but not limited to, escort services, companionship, sexual massage services or matchmaking services.
- d. Nudity and sexually – oriented material.
- e. Material that is obscene or adult in nature.

2. Alcohol, Illegal Drugs and Tobacco

- a. Alcohol and alcoholic beverages.
- b. Tobacco and other smokable products.
- c. E-cigarettes, E-vapourisers, liquids and related products.
- d. Illegal drugs and drug paraphernalia.

3. Animals, Animal Products and Plants

- a. Live animals of any kind.
- b. Skin and bones from endangered or exotic species.
- c. Hunting trophies.
- d. Items made from animals including, but not limited to, endangered or exotic animals.
- e. Plants or insects that are restricted or regulated.

4. Counterfeit and Replica Items

- a. Counterfeit items or knock-off brand name items.
- b. Items that infringe copyright laws including, but not limited to, software or other digital items which you are not authorised to sell.

5. Illegal Items or Encouraging Illegal Activity

- a. Stolen or illegal items.
- b. Items or listings that facilitate, promote, support or seek to engage users in illegal activity.
- c. Items you do not have authority to sell.

6. Weapons and Other Dangerous Items

- a. All firearms, accessories, explosives and ammunition.
- b. BB, paintball, pellet guns or other novelty guns.
- c. Tasers, stun guns.
- d. Knives, swords, hand weapons, bow and arrow and related equipment unless determined to be used for non-lethal sports or costume purposes.
- e. Burglary tools.
- f. Fireworks.
- g. Hazardous chemicals or controlled substances including, but not limited to, tear gas, pesticides, radioactive, toxic and explosive materials.

7. Medical or Healthcare Items

- a. Whitening or slimming pills.
- b. Medical devices.
- c. Medicine, medicinal instruments and items with objectionable medical claims.
- d. Injectable health/cosmetic substances.
- e. Prescription drugs, over the counter drugs and supplements.
- f. Adoption or surrogacy services.

8. Offensive Material

- a. Content that seeks to shame others and/or reveal personal information of others
- b. Content that promotes, supports or glorifies hatred and seeks to discriminate and/or demean on the basis of race, religion, gender, gender identity, disability or sexual orientation

9. Other

- a. Human beings, human remains and human body parts including, but not limited to, blood and breast milk.
- b. Opened and used cosmetics.
- c. Lottery tickets, sweepstakes, slot machines or gambling.
- d. Items obtained through government assistance including, but not limited to, government badges, uniforms, identification tags, documents and licences.
- e. Sales of currency as a product (e.g. cryptocurrency, euros, dollars etc), stock or other securities and related mining equipment (However, collectibles are permitted).
- f. Recalled items, banned items or items that do not meet the mandatory product safety standards.
- g. Moneylending services.
- h. Listings promoting Multi-Level-Marketing programs, Get-Rich-Quick schemes, pyramid selling schemes and Commission-only schemes.
- i. Embargoed items.
- j. Identity documents, personal financial records, personal information and mailing lists that contain names, addresses, phone numbers, or other personal identifying information.
- k. Illegal telecommunication and electronics equipment including, but not limited to, access cards, password sniffers, radar scanners, traffic signal control devices or cable descramblers.
- l. New merchandise or services from network marketing companies, work-from-home, independent franchisees or distributors, or similar representatives.
- m. Commercial tanning units or commercial tanning services (either selling or looking for).
- n. Votes in elections administered by the Australian Electoral Commission or state-based Electoral Commission or Census or other survey papers issued by the Australian Bureau of Statistic.
